As a follow-up to the successful "Starting the Conversation on the New Evangelization" workshops held throughout the state last August, the Diocese of Burlington is pleased to announce our participation in the New Evangelization Summit.

The conference will take place in Ottawa, Ontario Canada on Friday, May 12th and Saturday, May 13th and will be streamed to 28 host sites around North America, including our site at Holy Cross Parish in Colchester. It has been designed to inspire Catholics to strengthen their faith while drawing others into greater union with the Church founded by our Lord, Jesus Christ. This process, called "evangelization," is a fundamental calling for all Christians who strive to be examples of Christ's love in everything they do and make a concerted effort to spread the truth of the Gospel to all those who deserve to share in its promises of joy and salvation.

The Diocese will be live-streaming the Summit to Holy Cross Catholic Church, 416 Church Rd., Colchester, Vermont from 7:00pm to 9:30pm (EDT) on Friday, May 12th (registration starting at 6:15pm) continuing through Saturday, May 13th from 9:00am to 4:30pm. An enthusiastic volunteer staff from the Vermont "Challengers" and the "New Evangelization Steering Committee" will provide the full conference experience for all attendees by providing


