Care of Creation

Sept. 1 is the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Three years ago Pope Francis called for the Catholic Church to participate in the global observation, which has been celebrated by the Orthodox Church since 1989.

"The annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation will offer individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live," said the pope in the 2015 letter establishing the participation of the Catholic Church in this day of prayer.

The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation ushers in the Season of Creation, which runs from Sept. 1 through Oct. 4, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, patron of ecology.


