Officials from the archbishop

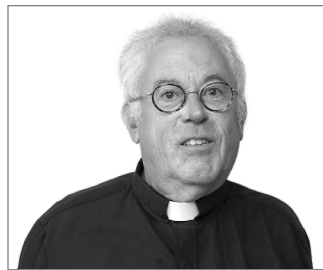
Archbishop Christopher Coyne has announced the following official transfers of priests.

The **Reverend Charles "Rick" Danielson** is granted senior priest status (*effective May 17*).



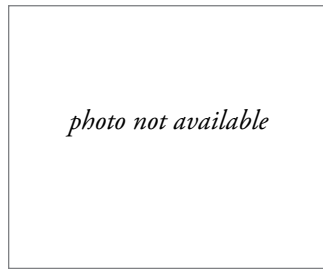

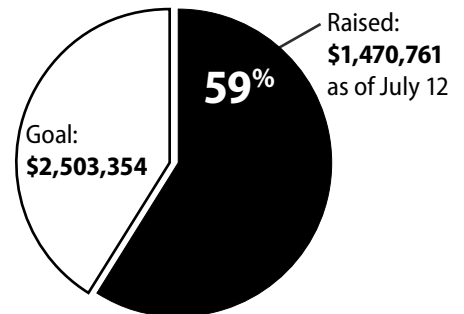
