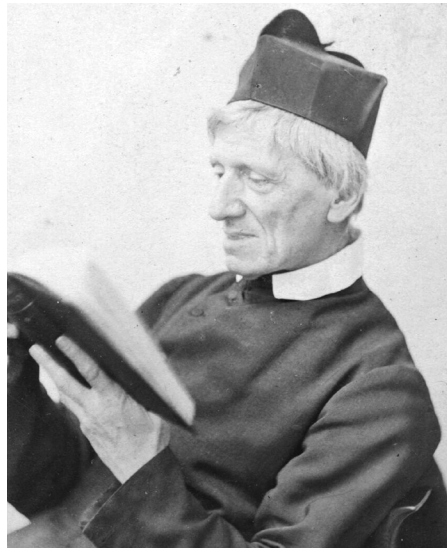
Fifth Annual Celebration of St. John Henry Cardinal Newman
