The Night of Love Vigil of Reparation is a response to Our Lord's request that reparation for the sins of mankind be made to His Sacred Heart and Mary's Immaculate Heart, specifically on the First Friday of the month into the First Saturday of the month.

The Night of Love Service will be held at Christ the King Parish in Burlington on the evening of November 1, beginning with All Saints Day/First Friday Mass at 5:30 pm, and concluding with First Saturday Mass/All Souls Day at midnight, November 2. Barb Ernster from the World Apostolate of Fatima national office will join us as a guest speaker for a short part of the program. The evening will also offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation with visiting Priests, a Procession with Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Investiture of the Brown Scapular, praying the various Mysteries of the Rosary as a Community of Faith, moments of prayer and reflection, songs and hymns of praise, and quiet times for individual prayer.

A night vigil of reparation, developed by the World Apostolate of Fatima, is an ideal response to the Hearts of Jesus and Mary for reparation, for our own sins and those of the whole world. It provides opportunities to fulfill the requirements for both the First Friday devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the First Saturday devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Bishop Andrew Cozzens, of Crookston, Minnesota, and chairman of the National Eucharistic Congress, has endorsed this initiative. "As the chairman of the USCCB Eucharistic Revival Initiative, I look to apostolates such as the World
